

FAQs:

How often should I change my filter?

For throw away filters, change every 1 to 3 months, depending on the type of filter. For cleanable filters, clean once a month.

How often should I have maintenance done on my system?

Twice a year: Once in spring for A/C and once in the fall for the furnace.

By replacing my old equipment will it save money on my monthly utility bill?

Yes, by as much as 36%.

Will freon be available after 2010?

Yes, but only for repairs not for new equipment and at higher cost than the earth friendly Puron refrigerant.

What causes power outages?

38% Lightning and other weather: wind, rain, snow, heat, cold and ice

26% Utility equipment problems and grid overload

12% Fallen trees or tree growth

10% Animal contact

8% Human error: underground digging, cranes, traffic, vandalism

6% Miscellaneous: mechanical damage, construction, fire
